Our students were part of the volunteering crew, they also took part in singing as part of the inaugural ceremony. The students attended the event with great enthusiasm.

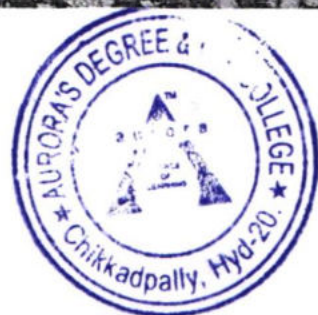
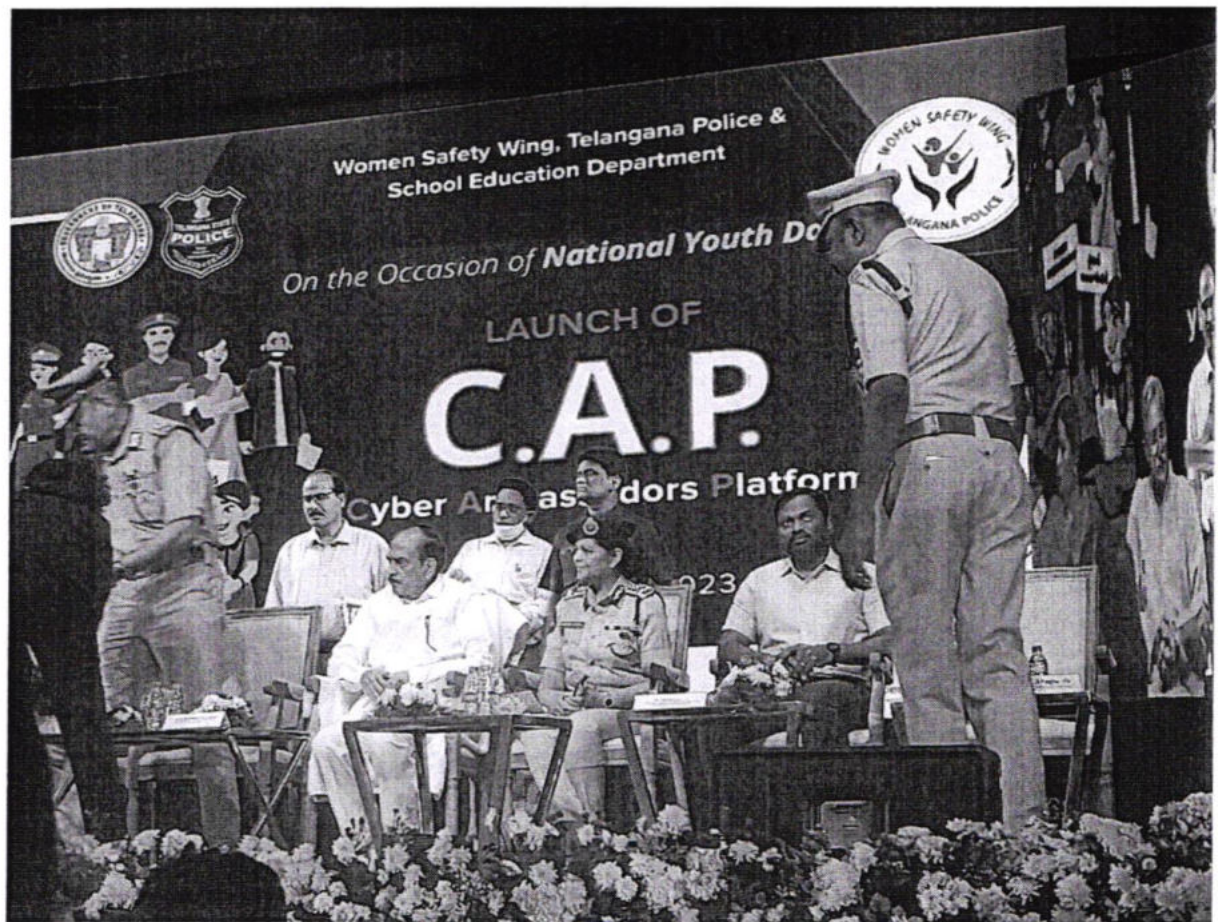

BRIEF ABOUT THE EVENT:

Under the initiative of the Social Activity Cell of Aurora's Degree & PG College, Hyderabad, celebrated World Sparrow Day to raise awareness on the house sparrow and other common birds and threats to their population. This day is observed on 20th March every year. This year, the theme for World Sparrow Day is "I Love Sparrows". Every year the day is celebrated with the goal to create public awareness about the sparrows in the environment and the threat they are facing these days. Mr. Shrief Akbar delivered lecture on "Avian Diversity-Birds of Telangana", importance of conserving the house sparrow and other birds and the adverse effects that the decline in their population would produce on the ecosystem. The state of Telangana, India, has 497 bird species within its boundaries. He highlighted that, the conservation of sparrows could only be established through maintaining sparrow friendly habitats, using minimum quantity of pesticides and raising public understanding on the relationship among birds, human and environment. 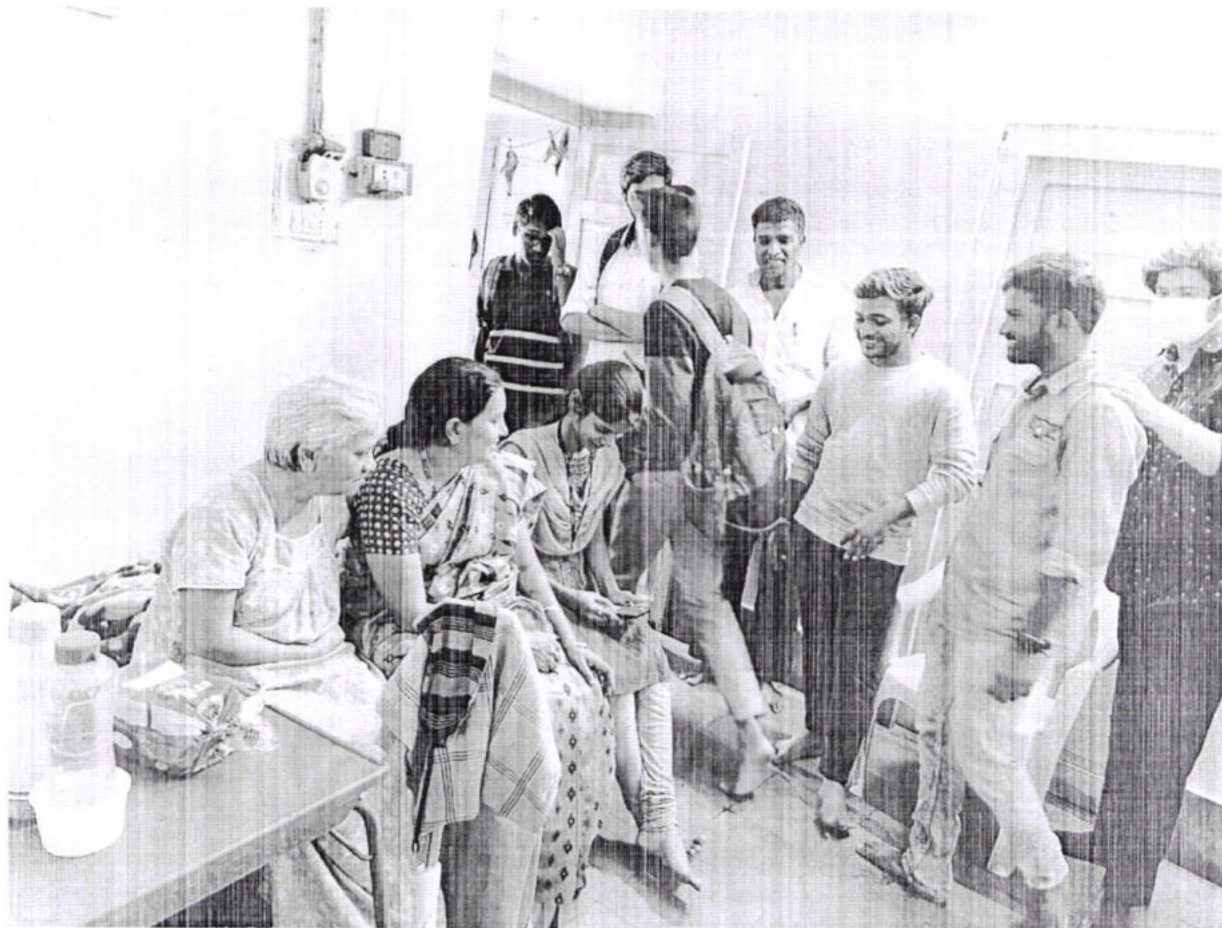
PARAGRAPH ABOUT THE PROCEEDINGS:

About the program:

Our principal supported the NCC's initiative and gave us the push we needed for this drive."

"It is really good that the college has started this vaccination drive so that students can stay safe and the spread of COVID-19 can be controlled. Now that the government has said that offline classes should start, this is a must" said Gayathri, a student of B.SC.

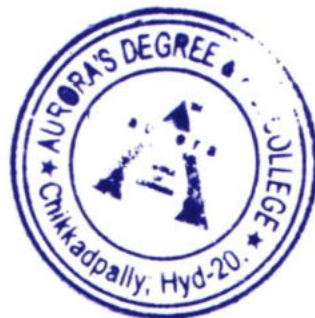
